Essay Contest

The Bartlesville Rotary Scholarship Essay contest offers students in the Bartlesville area (BPS, Dewey, Copan, Caney Valley, Wesleyan Christian School, and home-schooled students) an opportunity to stand out based on their writing, creativity, research, and knowledge of Rotary. In addition to submitting an approximately 500-word essay, top finalists will be asked to read their essays during a Rotary noon meeting. Students must be available to read their essays to qualify for the scholarship. Essays of high quality may receive a scholarship of \$250 up to \$1,000. Of particular importance for the paper will be originality, imagination, content, and incorporation of one of the topics below.

The essay topics may include:

- Influence of the 4 Way test in the lives of those who practice this belief.
- What does “Service above Self” look like?
- What does Rotary do for the community? the state? the world?
- Why would I want to become a Rotarian?

The format **must** be as follows:

- MLA Format (Times New Roman 12 pt. font, double spaced, 1-inch margins)
- Students must use proper citations and references

The deadline for submitting entries is October 14, 2022.
